A Seder is the Jewish ritual service and ceremonial dinner celebrated on the

first night or first two nights of Passover. Many Christians celebrate Seder to honor the command God gave to Moses and the Israelites and to recognize its connection with the Last Supper Jesus ate with his closest disciples.

In this tradition, following an adapted version of the Passover service Jesus would have led on the night he was betrayed, we will share a Passover style meal.

The dinner menu will include:

- Matzo ball soup
- Raw veggie plate/salad
- Baked chicken
- Potatoes
- Green beans
- Oranged carrots
- Dessert

Special Guests: Confirmation students, all those receiving First Communion and their families, and all other members are welcome.
